In her remarks, the Chairman of the EFCC, Mrs Farida Waziri acknowledged the support of the European union and other donor agencies for the establishment of the Centre in particular and in the The antigraft boss, noted further that, the EU has been consistent in its support for the Commission, saying, "I make bold to say clearly that their support has been total, unqualified and unconditional. "The data centre commissioning illustrates clearly and in concrete terms what the cooperation between the commission and the development partners present here can achieve"" she added. The Head of European Commission delegation, Mr Denis Thieulin, in his remarks said the EC, "is proud to be associated with the hardwork and successes of the EFCC in the fight against corruption.
